³ HPV vaccine is publicly funded only for females in Grade 8

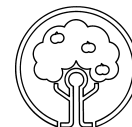
⁴ Varicella vaccine is publicly funded only for 1 year old **OR** 5 year old children who have not yet had the Chickenpox

SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE HEALTH UNIT

- **Immunization clinics** are routinely held at various sites across Renfrew County for infants, children and adults. Please see reverse for Clinic locations and times.
- **Hepatitis B** vaccine is only offered free of charge to all grade 7 students or high risk persons and it is given in a two (2) dose system for persons 12-16 years of age. Adults or young children are given three (3) doses of Hepatitis B.
- **Men - C** vaccine is offered free of charge to all grade 7 students, 15 – 19 year olds and high risk persons.
- **Child Health Clinics** are also available for families with newborns and children up to age six. Please call 613-735-8666 or 1-800-267-1097 Ext. 666 for more information.
- **Tuberculosis or TB Mantoux Skin testing** is also available.

- **Human Papillomavirus (HPV)** is offered free of charge only to Grade 8 females. It is given in a three (3) dose system.
- **Influenza** vaccinations are available free of charge to all residents of Ontario beginning late Fall.
