All pregnant women can now get their H1N1 vaccine, the Renfrew County and District Health Unit has announced.

“We have received a supply of unadjuvanted vaccine, which is for pregnant women only at this time,” said Dr. Michael Corriveau, Medical Officer of Health.

The vaccine for pregnant women will also be available at community clinics, but if you don’t want to wait in line, make an appointment and get it at a health unit office.
