



Has the client considered what resources they would like to use to quit smoking?

NICOTINE REPLACEMENT THERAPY (NRT)

- May include: Patch, gum, lozenge, inhaler and mouth spray
- NRT available for purchase over the counter at local pharmacies. Sources of free NRT are outlined below.

Does the client belong to a Family Health Team (FHT) or Community Health Centre (CHC)?

YES

STOP with Family Health Teams
Must be a client of the FHT* (see over for list of FHTs)
 Smoking cessation support, including:

- Free Nicotine Replacement Therapy up to 26 weeks
- Counselling

STOP with Community Health Centres
Must be client of the CHC (see over for list of CHCs)
 Smoking cessation support, including:

- Free Nicotine Replacement Therapy up to 26 weeks
- Counselling

STOP with Addiction Agencies
Open to Renfrew County and District residents (see over for list of Addiction Agencies)
 Smoking cessation support, including:

- Free Nicotine Replacement Therapy up to 26 weeks
- Counselling

Does the client have Private Health Insurance?

If a client has health insurance (through work, for example) advise the client to call their insurance provider to see what their plan covers.

Some over the counter medications may be covered by private insurance if they obtain a prescription from a Primary Care Provider.

Is the client on Social Assistance (OW/ODSP)?

Funding for NRT may be available through social assistance. Consult social assistance caseworker.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS

Champix (Varenicline) or Zyban (Bupropion)

Pharmacists can:

- Prescribe medications for smoking cessation
- Provide smoking cessation counselling

Advise clients to talk to their pharmacist.

If client is on social assistance (OW/ODSP), the Ontario Drug Benefit Program will cover Champix or Zyban for 12 weeks with a prescription from a Primary Care Provider.

If client has Private Health Insurance, have them check with their insurance provider to see what their plan covers.
