

RCD COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Key Message

Appointments will be sent to the email address that individuals provided at the vaccination clinic. For individuals who did not provide an email at the vaccination site, RCDHU call centre personnel as well as community partners, will begin calling to schedule a second dose appointment. **There is no need to book your second appointment online, as appointments will be created for you.**

For individuals eligible to book their **first dose** vaccination appointment, visit www.rcdhu.com/novel-coronavirus-covid-19-vaccine-rollout. **Please book only one appointment per person** to ensure that appointments are available to other eligible individuals. **If you book an appointment, please keep it.** If it is critical to change your appointment, **please cancel through the link in the email** you received confirming your appointment.
