# **Key Message**

Residents who have been unable to book a vaccine appointment due to high demand can now add their name to the Weekly Extra Dose Sign-up List. If you want your name on the list, you must sign up every Monday morning for the current week. This Extra Dose Sign-Up List is not in place of booking an appointment and everyone should continue to book appointments as they become available. Early second dose appointments for Indigenous adults aged 18+ and seniors aged 80+ can be booked through the Extra Dose Sign-up list.

Please book only one **appointment per person** to ensure that appointments are available to other eligible individuals. If you book an appointment, please keep it. If it is critical to change your appointment, please cancel through the link in the email you received confirming your appointment.

## Eligible people who can book first dose appointments:

**Residents in the general population aged 12** and over (must be 12 years of age as of the date of vaccination)

\*All those previously eligible will remain eligible to book an appointment

Vaccine clinic dates and times are only available based on vaccine supply.

Eligibility expansion will result in **longer wait times** for appointments.

**Please be patient** as you wait for appointments to become available.
