An online vaccine booking system has been set up for RCD! Individuals that are currently eligible for vaccination can visit **www.rcdhu.com** or ontario.ca/bookvaccine to register. If you can't access the online system, please ask a family member or friend to assist you.



If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613–735–9724 or 1-800-267-1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.

Availability of vaccination appointments will be based on the number of vaccine doses that RCD receives each week. Because of this, people should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks for everyone in the new groupings to be able to book and receive their vaccinations.
