Key Messages

Eligible people who can currently register for a vaccination appointment can visit www.rcdhu.com or ontario.ca/bookvaccine. If you can't access the online system, ask a family member or friend to assist you.



If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613–735–9724 or 1-800-267-1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.

Following the National Advisory Committee on Immunization's recommendation to delay the second dose, **all second doses**, except for a minority of classifications, will be administered 16 weeks after the first. Eligible people will receive notification on when they can register for their second vaccination appointment.
