COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC SCHEDULE



Renfrew County and District (RCD)

September 04 - September 17, 2022



Anyone 5 years of age and older can <u>visit a pharmacy to get their COVID-19 vaccine</u>, <u>subject to vaccine availability</u>. Be sure to **call the pharmacy ahead of time** if you plan to get vaccinated there, as vaccine supply varies and appointments may be required.



<u>First or second doses</u>: Anyone 6 months of age or older (wait at least eight weeks between doses).



<u>First booster dose</u>: Residents 12 years of age or older can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their second dose (on or before **June 19, 2022**).

*NEW <u>Children 5-11 years of age can receive their first booster dose</u> at a minimum of three months (84 days) after their second dose (on or before June 19, 2022).



<u>Second booster dose</u>: Anyone 18 years of age and older (strongly recommended for those at greater risk of experiencing severe outcomes due to COVID-19 infection) can receive a second booster dose at a minimum of three months (84 days) with informed consent after their first booster dose (on or before Jun 19, 2022).
