Renfrew County and District (RCD) COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Updated: June 23, 2021

Key Messages

- Eligible residents are being urged to book an early second dose appointment as soon as possible, through <u>RCDs online booking system</u>.
- As of June 28th, early second dose appointments are available for anyone who is 18 years of age or older who has had an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna) at least 28 days ago, or for those who have had an AstraZeneca vaccine at least 8 weeks ago.
- People who have been unable to book a vaccine appointment due to high demand can add their name to the Weekly Extra Dose Sign-up List.
- Residents can cancel their appointment through <u>RCDs online booking system</u>, the link in the original vaccination appointment email, or by calling RCDHU at 613-732-3629 ext. 202.

Eligible people who can book first dose appointments:

Residents in the general population aged 12 and over (must be 12 years of age as of the date of vaccination)

Eligible people who can book early second dose appointments:

- Any individuals who received their first dose of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna) on or before May 9, 2021.
- Anyone who received the AstraZeneca vaccine are also eligible to receive a second dose of a COVID-19 vaccine at an interval of eight to 12 weeks, with informed consent.

Vaccine clinic dates and times are only available based on vaccine supply. Eligibility expansion will result in **longer wait times** for appointments. **Please be patient** as you wait for appointments to become available.
