The LEARNING AND LAUGHTER - Supporting Teens in Reducing Their Stress (and Ours!) event will focus on how parents, caregivers, teachers, social workers, sports coaches, etc. can help foster non-cognitive skills such as self-control, grit and resilience in a supportive environment without arguing. Specifically, it will present techniques such as mindfulness meditation, effective communication and using natural highs as healthy coping mechanisms against stress, alcohol and other drug use and bullying behaviour.

Come to learn, stay for the laughs and network over refreshments as Dr. Bellace guides you through the current research on adolescent brain development and the need to support young people in both words and actions if we want them to make healthy choices for themselves.
