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As mandated by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, the Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) supports teachers, students, and parents with health-related programs and services that reflect the expectations of the Ontario Health and Physical Education Curriculum and the Ontario Public Health Standards.

A health promoter or public health nurse is assigned to your school to assist with implementing components of the pillars of Comprehensive School Health: Social and Physical Environments, Teaching and Learning, Healthy Schools Policy, and Partnerships and Services.

Health Unit staff also provide: Immunization Clinics, Dental Screening, Food Safety Consultations, and Tobacco Control.

Steps Towards A Youth Engagement Strategy: Renfrew County Youth Needs Assessment Report

RCYN, with leadership from the RCDHU, teamed up with The Students Commission of Canada and Three Things Consulting to hear what youth in Renfrew County and District think about their community and what can be done to make the county more youth friendly. The data from The Youth Needs Assessment came from 655 online surveys and 77 youth who participated in six sharing circles. The goal is to build a "Youth Engagement Strategy" to help improve the lives of youth growing up in Renfrew County.
