



## COVID-19 Attestation for Return to Work Following Illness

- My symptoms are not new and have not changed. I was previously seen by a doctor or nurse practitioner and was diagnosed with a chronic condition, such as allergies or asthma, with the exact same symptoms that I have now.
- I was assessed by a doctor or nurse practitioner since I was sent home or denied entry to work. The doctor or nurse practitioner told me that another diagnosis (medical reason) other than COVID-19 explains my symptoms and did not recommend that I be tested for COVID-19 at this time.
- I did NOT have a COVID-19 test but completed 10 days of self-isolation from the date I started to feel sick **AND** I have not had a fever for at least 24 hours without medication **AND** my symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours.
- I have received a negative COVID-19 test after starting to feel sick **AND** my symptoms have been improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours with vomiting or diarrhea)\* **AND** I have not had a fever in over 24 hours without medication **AND** I have **NOT** been told by Renfrew County and District Health Unit or a healthcare provider to continue to self-isolate for a total of 14 days because I was a close contact of a person with COVID-19.\*\*

*\*As long as you have a negative COVID-19 test, mild symptoms like a runny nose do not have to be completely resolved when you return to work, provided the runny nose (or other mild symptom) is improving and other symptoms have stopped.*

*\*\*If you were identified as a close contact of a person with COVID-19, a Negative COVID-19 test **DOES NOT** end your self-isolation. You are still required to isolate for the full 14 days from your last exposure to the positive person.*
