
Key Messages

- An online vaccine booking system has been set up for RCD! Individuals that are currently eligible for vaccination can visit **www.rcdhu.com** to register. If you can't access the online system, please ask a family member or friend to assist you.
- If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613–735–9724 or 1–800–267–1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am 4:00 pm. Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.
- Availability of vaccination appointments will be based on the number of vaccine doses that RCD receives each week. Because of this, people should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks for everyone in the new groupings to be able to book and receive their vaccinations.

Phase 1:


- Adults 80+ (born in 1941 or earlier)
- Retirement Home residents
- Indigenous adults 55+ (born in 1966 or earlier)
- Retirement Home essential caregivers
- Note: Vaccine shipments vary for each public health region; as such, some regions are able to progress to vaccinating different populations at a faster rate.

Phase 1: Upcoming Populations Timelines to be announced

- High priority healthcare workers
- All Indigenous adults, including those under 55 years of age
- Adults receiving chronic home care
