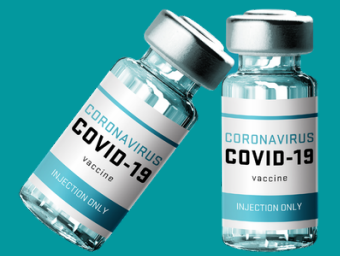


# RCD COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Update: April 14, 2021



## Key Messages

**1.** Residents born in 1966 or earlier can book AstraZeneca vaccination appointments at RCD's public clinics and participating pharmacies. To view a list of participating pharmacies, visit: <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/vaccine-locations>. **All other appointments for AstraZeneca vaccinations will be booked online at [www.rcdhu.com](http://www.rcdhu.com).**

**2.** If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613-735-9724 or 1-800-267-1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. **Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.**

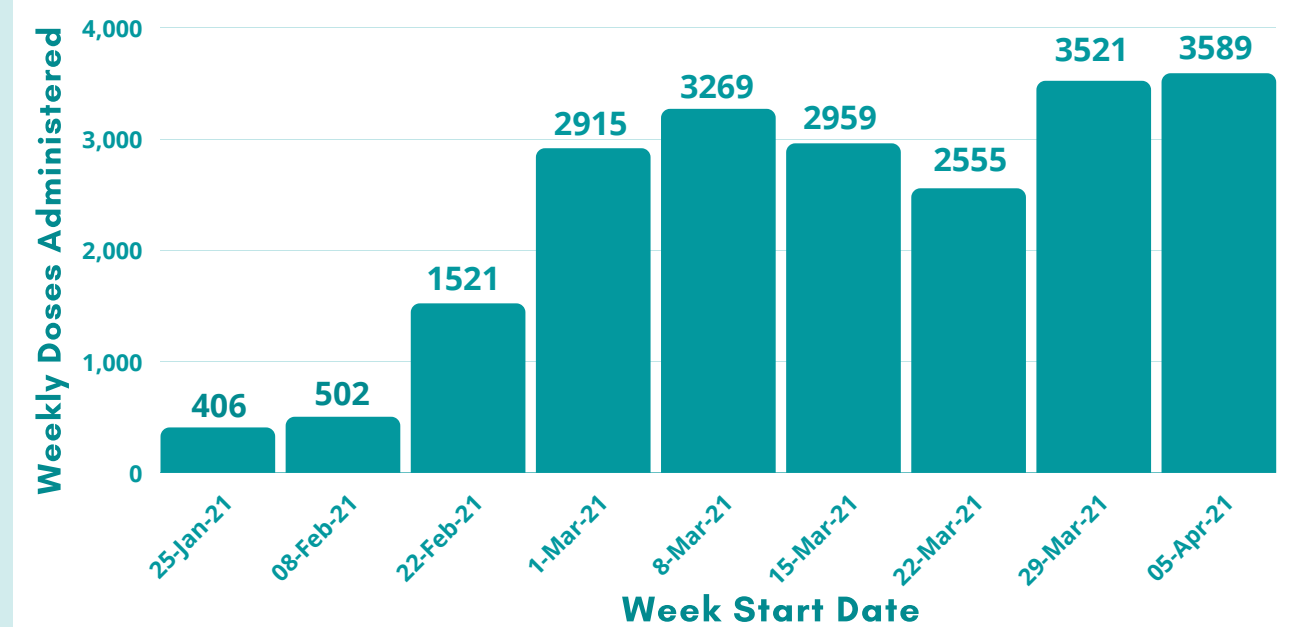
**3.** Following the National Advisory Committee on Immunization's recommendation to delay the second dose, **all second doses, except for a minority of classifications, will be administered 16 weeks after the first.** Eligible people will receive notification on when they can register for their second vaccination appointment.

## Eligible people who can pre-register & book appointments



### Phase 2:

- > People born in 1956 or earlier (65 years of age and older)
- > Indigenous adults 18+
- > All healthcare workers
- > Anyone else who is part of previously eligible groups from Phase 1\*
- > Residents born in 1966 or earlier (55 years of age and older) are eligible to book an appointment for the AstraZeneca vaccine.
- > All residents and staff of congregate living facilities
- > Education staff supporting students with complex special education needs.
- > Residents with certain high-risk health conditions and one essential caregiver for these residents\*

## Eligible people who can pre-register but are currently unable to book an appointment

- > People 60-64 years of age (born between 1957-1961)

**i Note:** Vaccine appointment availability will be based on the number of doses that RCD receives each week. People should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks to complete the eligible groups.
