
# **Key Messages**

- Residents born in 1966 or earlier can book AstraZeneca vaccination appointments at RCD's public clinics and participating pharmacies. All other appointments for AstraZeneca vaccinations will be booked online at <a href="https://www.rcdhu.com">www.rcdhu.com</a>.
- If you can't register online, please call RCDHU at 613–735–9724 or 1–800–267–1097 extension 200. The phone lines will be answered 7 days/week, from 8:00 am 4:00 pm. Please leave your name and number, and only leave one voice message.
- Following the National Advisory Committee on Immunization's recommendation to delay the second dose, all second doses, except for a minority of classifications, will be administered 16 weeks after the first. Eligible people will receive notification on when they can register for their second vaccination appointment.

#### Phase 2:


- People born in 1956 or earlier (65 years of age and older)
- Indigenous adults 18+
- All healthcare workers
- Anyone else who is part of previously eligible groups from Phase 1\*
- Residents born in 1966 or earlier (55 years of age and older) are eligible to book an appointment for the AstraZeneca vaccine.
- All residents and staff of congregate living facilities
- Education staff supporting students with complex special education needs.
- Residents with certain high-risk health conditions and one essential caregiver for these residents\*

- People 60-64 years of age (born between 1957-1961)
- Note: Vaccine appointment availability will be based on the number of doses that RCD receives each week. People should anticipate that it will take a number of weeks to complete the eligible groups.
