

RCD COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout at a Glance

Key Message

For individuals eligible to book a vaccination appointment, visit www.rcdhu.com. **Please book only one appointment per person** to ensure that appointments are available to other eligible individuals. **If you book an appointment, please keep it.** If it is critical to change your appointment, **please cancel through the link in the email** you received confirming your appointment.

If you are concerned about which vaccine will be provided to you at your appointment, please be reminded that **the best COVID-19 vaccine is the one that is currently available to you.** Individuals do not get to choose in advance which vaccine they will receive, as you will receive the vaccine that is available at the time.

Note: COVID-19 vaccination appointments are fully booked through May and starting into June. Please monitor the [registration page for more appointments](#).

Phase 2:

- > People born in 1961 or earlier (60 years of age and older)
- > Indigenous adults 18+
- > Anyone else who is previously eligible from Phase 1*
- > All residents and staff of congregate living facilities
- > People born in 1981 or earlier (40 years of age and older) can book an appointment for the AstraZeneca vaccine
- > Education staff supporting students with complex special education needs
- > Residents with certain high-risk health conditions and one essential caregiver*
- > Child care workers in licensed child care settings (starting April 29)
