# **Diseases of Public Health Significance:** January - December 2020

## **Reportable Diseases**

- In Ontario, nearly 70 communicable diseases are reportable to the local Medical Officer of Health as per Ontario Regulation 135/18 and amendments under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, R.S.O. c.H.7. A full list of the reportable diseases of public health significance can be found by visiting <u>www.rcdhu.com</u>.
- Health Care Practitioners, hospital administrators, superintendents of institutions and school principals who become aware of these diseases are responsible for reporting them to the local public health unit.
- Prompt reporting enables the public health unit to complete timely follow-up with the affected individuals and their contacts and implement measures to further prevent transmission.

 Data Source: Integrated Public Health Information System (iPHIS) accessed through Infectious Diseases Query, Public Health Ontario (PHO). Extracted April 21, 2021. iPHIS is a dynamic reporting system which allows ongoing updates to data previously entered. As a result, data extracted from iPHIS represent a snap shot at the time of extraction and may differ from previous or subsequent reports.

 Case counts for amebiasis, invasive Haemophilus influenzae disease (all types), invasive meningococcal disease, Lyme disease, mumps, pertussis, and West Nile Virus illness are based on the sum of confirmed and probable cases as reported in iPHIS. All other diseases reported in the table are based on confirmed cases only.
