Update Regarding COVID-19 Vaccine Walk-In Clinics

Today, Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) is announcing that **COVID-19 walk-in** vaccination clinics are available for residents ages 75 and over, who have not yet booked a <u>second dose</u>, and residents ages 12 to 74 who not yet received a <u>first dose</u>. Please remember that walk-in appointments are subject to vaccine availability.
