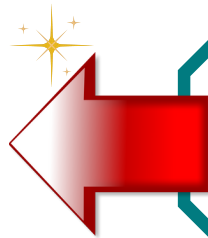


Renfrew County and District (RCD) May 15 - May 28, 2022

Check with your local pharmacy to see if you can get your dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Eligible residents can book their first or second dose appointments online. Residents that are 18 years of age or older can book their booster dose appointment if they received their second dose on or before **Feb 20, 2022 (Nov 24, 2021 for youth 12-17).**

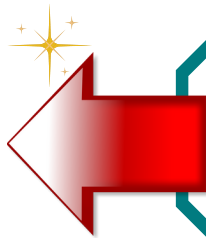
