Changes to Provincial Masking Requirements

Effective June 11, 2022

Effective Saturday, June 11, 2022 at 12:01 a.m.

- Masks must be worn in long-term care and retirement homes.
- Masking is recommended in higher-risk congregate living settings, such as shelters and group homes.

Although masking requirements are being removed in most settings, it is strongly recommended to continue the use of masks in indoor public settings to help protect against COVID-19 infection. This is <u>especially true</u> if someone has higher personal health risks or if their close family or friends include those who are vulnerable to severe infection.
