

# COVID-19 VACCINE FOURTH DOSE OR SECOND BOOSTER DOSE

## WHO IS CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A FOURTH DOSE OR SECOND BOOSTER DOSE?

Residents that are 18 years or older, or those that are **12-17 year of age who are moderately to severely immuno-compromised** are eligible for a fourth dose at a recommended interval of **five months (140 days) after receiving their first booster dose**. It may be given as early as **three months (84 days)** with informed consent.

Residents who have been infected with COVID-19 after their first booster dose but before their second booster dose are recommended to **wait at least three months (84 days)** after symptoms or when the positive test result was received.



## HOW CAN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS OBTAIN A FOURTH DOSE OR SECOND BOOSTER DOSE VACCINATION APPOINTMENT?

Eligible residents can **contact their local pharmacy to see if they have vaccines available**, or walk-in to any of the clinics listed in the current COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Schedule, [found here](#).
