COVID-19 VACCINE FOURTH DOSE OR SECOND **BOOSTER DOSE**





Residents that are 18 years or older, or those that are 12-17 year of age who are moderately to severely immuno-compromised are eligible for a fourth dose at a recommended interval of five months (140 days) after receiving their first booster dose. It may be given as early as three months (84 days) with informed consent.

Residents who have been infected with COVID-19 after their first booster dose but before their second booster dose are recommended to wait at least three months (84 days) after symptoms or when the positive test result was received.

HOW CAN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS OBTAIN A FOURTH DOSE OR **SECOND BOOSTER DOSE VACCINATION APPOINTMENT?**
