
School Immunization Catch-up



All children attending school between the **ages of 4 to 17 need to be immunized** according to <u>Ontario's</u> <u>immunization schedule</u>, **unless they have a valid exemption**. Immunization protects children from many serious diseases that are easily spread in the community.

Under the <u>Immunization of School Pupils Act (ISPA</u>), children need to have proof of immunization against:

- Diphtheria
 Tetanus
 Polio
- MeaslesMumps
- 🗸 Rubella
