

# COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC SCHEDULE

STOP COVID-19

## Renfrew County and District (RCD) August 01 - August 31, 2022



Anyone 5 years of age and older can [visit a pharmacy to get their COVID-19 vaccine, subject to vaccine availability](#). Be sure to **call the pharmacy ahead of time** if you plan to get vaccinated there, as vaccine supply varies and appointments may be required.



**First or second doses: \*NEW** Anyone 6 months of age or older (wait at least eight weeks between doses).



**First booster dose:** Anyone 12 years of age or older.

- Residents 12-17 years of age can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **six months (168 days)** after their second dose (on or before **Feb 20, 2022**).
- Residents 18 years of age or older can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their second dose (on or before **May 15, 2022**).



**Second booster dose:** Anyone 18 years of age and older (**strongly recommended for those at greater risk of experiencing severe outcomes due to COVID-19 infection**) can receive a second booster dose **five months (140 days)** after their first booster dose (on or before **Mar 20, 2022**), or at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** with informed consent after their first booster dose (on or before **May 15, 2022**). ## Renfrew County and District (RCD) August 01 - August 31, 2022



Anyone 5 years of age and older can [visit a pharmacy to get their COVID-19 vaccine, subject to vaccine availability](#). Be sure to **call the pharmacy ahead of time** if you plan to get vaccinated there, as vaccine supply varies and appointments may be required.



**First or second doses:** **\*NEW** Anyone 6 months of age or older (wait at least eight weeks between doses).



**First booster dose:** Anyone 12 years of age or older.

- Residents 12-17 years of age can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **six months (168 days)** after their second dose (on or before **Feb 20, 2022**).
- Residents 18 years of age or older can receive their first booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their second dose (on or before **May 15, 2022**).



**Second booster dose:** Anyone 18 years of age and older (**strongly recommended for those at greater risk of experiencing severe outcomes due to COVID-19 infection**) can receive a second booster dose **five months (140 days)** after their first booster dose (on or before **Mar 20, 2022**), or at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** with informed consent after their first booster dose (on or before **May 15, 2022**).
