COVID-19 VACCINE THIRD DOSE OR FIRST BOOSTER DOSE







WHO IS CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A THIRD DOSE OR **BOOSTER DOSE?**

Immunocompromised individuals and those receiving dialysis (hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis) are eligible for a third dose after eight weeks (56 days) since their second dose.

- Residents 12 years of age or older are eligible to receive a booster dose at a minimum of three months (84 days) after a second dose.
- *NEW Children 5-11 years of age are eligible to receive a booster six months (168 days) after a second dose, or at a minimum of three months (84 days) with informed consent.
- Those who have been infected with COVID-19 after their primary series but before their booster dose are recommended to wait at least three months (84 days) after symptoms or when the positive test result was received.



HOW CAN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS OBTAIN A THIRD DOSE OR **BOOSTER DOSE VACCINATION APPOINTMENT?**

No appointments are necessary, as eligible individuals can walk-in to any 5+ clinic taking place across RCD.
