
COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC SCHEDULE



Renfrew County and District (RCD) October 17 - October 31, 2022

Review this list of <u>participating pharmacies</u> to see if you can receive your COVID-19 vaccine, subject to vaccine availability. Be sure to **call the pharmacy ahead of time** if you plan to get vaccinated there, as vaccine supply varies and appointments may be required.



COVID-19

B<u>ooster doses</u>: Residents 5-11 years of age can receive a monovalent booster dose at the recommended interval of **six months (168 days)** after a previous COVID-19 vaccine (**on or before May 22, 2022**). A booster dose can be provided at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their last dose, with informed consent (**on or before Jul 31, 2022**).

Bivalent booster doses: Residents 12 years of age and older can receive the bivalent booster dose at a recommended interval of **six months (168 days)** after a previous COVID-19 vaccine (**on or before May 22, 2022**). A bivalent booster dose can be provided at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after their last dose, with informed consent (**on or before Jul 31, 2022**).
