

COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Information

First or Second Doses



- Available to anyone **six months of age and older**.
- It is recommended to wait **at least eight weeks between doses**. *Note: with informed consent, individuals can receive a second dose after 28 days.*

Bivalent Booster Doses



- Available to anyone **5 years of age and older**.
- It is recommended to wait **six months (168 days)** after receiving a previous COVID-19 vaccine (i.e., your last dose was received **on or before Sep 11, 2022**).
- **Note:** With informed consent, you can choose to receive a bivalent booster dose at a minimum of **three months (84 days)** after your last dose (i.e., your last dose was received **on or before Dec 04, 2022**).

Additional Recommendations



- Individuals 6 months of age and older can receive other vaccines at the same time or at any time before or after a COVID-19 vaccine, with informed consent.
