

## **Report Your Immunization Records**

Each time your child receives a vaccination, you are required to update Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) directly, as well as your Child Care Facility.

*Please note*: Health care providers and child care providers **do not** report immunization records for you.

According to the *Child Care and Early Years Act*, 2014, all children attending licenced childcare facilities in Ontario must provide proof of completed Immunization against the following diseases: diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), haemophilus Influenza B (Hib), polio, measles, mumps, rubella, rotavirus, pneumococcal, meningococcal disease and varicella (chicken pox).

A valid exemption needs to be submitted to RCDHU for parents who choose **not** to have the child vaccinated. If a child needs an exemption from immunization, contact RCDHU by calling 613-732-9436 or 1-833-773-0004.
