# Instructions for Collection, Maintenance and Completion of Child Care Forms for Licenced Child Care Facility Operators and Providers

## **Background**

The Child Care and Early Years Act requires all infants and children attending a Licenced Child Care Facility be fully immunized as recommended by the Medical Officer of Health. In Renfrew County and District this includes Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Poliomyelitis, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Haemophilus influenzae B, Rotavirus, Meningococcal disease, Pneumococcal disease, and Varicella (chickenpox).

Each Child Care facility is responsible for ensuring that the immunizations for each child/infant enrolled in the facility are up to date.

Each Child Care facility is also responsible for ensuring a record of immunization is kept on file at the facility, and another is forwarded to Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU).

#### **Immunization Schedule**

This schedule may change if a child misses any of the recommended immunizations. Please refer to the Immunization Assessment Tool (Appendix A) to ensure each child is up to date with the required immunizations to attend a Licensed Child Care Facility. If you have any questions about interpreting the schedule or an immunization record, please contact the Immunization Program for guidance at 613-732-9436 or 1-833-773-0004.

## **Process for New Registrants**

Ensure all children are immunized prior to registration. The operator/provider can do so by providing the parent/guardian with the following:

- ➤ Program Questionnaire (Appendix B) Demographic information about the child and parent is collected on this form. The parent/guardian will also be asked to provide a copy of their child's immunization record. The program questionnaire provided by RCDHU must be used. Legal names must be used on the form. Completed questionnaires must be forwarded to RCDHU from the Child Care facility with a complete Immunization record for each new attendee.
- Parent Handout 'Report your Immunizations' (Appendix C) This handout outlines the immunization requirements for children enrolled in Licensed Child Care Facilities in Renfrew County and District. It also highlights the importance of updating immunization information and the different methods parents/guardians can use to update their children's records with RCDHU.

Child Care Facilities can submit the completed Program Questionnaire electronically by completing the fillable PDF and emailing the form to <a href="mailto:immunization@rcdhu.com">immunization@rcdhu.com</a> or by faxing 613-735-3067.

## **Process for Reporting Enrollment**

Semi-annually, RCDHU will request that the Child Care Facility submit the 'Current Child Care Enrollment Report' (Appendix D). Child Care Facilities can submit their enrollment information electronically by completing the fillable PDF and emailing the form to immunization@rcdhu.com or by faxing 613-735-3067.

# Process for Parents Requesting an Immunization Exemption for Religious or Conscience or Medical Reasons

Some parents may choose not to immunize their child for religious or conscientious reasons while others may not be immunized for medical reasons.

Child Care providers can direct parents to the appropriate exemption form, or they can direct parents to contact RCDHU for help to access the form.

Once completed, the original copy of the exemption must be forwarded to RCDHU. The Child Care operator/provider can photocopy the completed form and store it in the child's file at their facility. The Statement of Medical Exemption must be completed by the child's Health Care Provider (a Medical Doctor registered with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario or Nurse

Practitioner Registered with the College of Nurses of Ontario) stating the reason for the medical exemption. The original copy must be forwarded to RCDHU, and the Child Care operator/provider can photocopy the completed form and store it in the child's file.

In the event of an outbreak related to a vaccine preventable disease, RCDHU may order the exclusion of children who have an incomplete immunization record from attendance at a Child Care facility until the risk related to the outbreak has ended. This is to minimize the risk of spreading the disease and to protect unvaccinated staff and children.

## **Process for Updating Records of Existing Registrants**

Child Care facilities must ensure that the immunizations of children already enrolled in their facility are up to date as per Ontario's routine Immunization schedule. To facilitate the collection of this information, the operator can provide the parent/guardian with the Handout – Report you child's Immunization (Appendix C). The parent/guardian is responsible for updating RCDHU each time their child receives an Immunization. The parent/guardian must also provide the Child Care facility with a copy of their updated Immunization Record as they also must keep an updated record at their facility. Some Child Care facilities may choose to submit the child's Immunization updates to RCDHU on behalf of the parents.

## **Immunization Surveillance**

Annually, RCDHU will review the immunization records for each child enrolled in licensed Child Care facilities in Renfrew County and District. RCDHU will identify children who are not up to date and will provide a notice of overdue Immunization to the child's parent/legal guardian. A due date in which they must submit their child's Immunization record will be provided in the written

notice. Following the due date, RCDHU will provide the operator with a list of children in their facility who are not up to date with their immunizations as set forth by the local Medical Officer of Health.

## **Immunization Requirement for Employees**

According to the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014, "Every licensee of a Child Care facility shall ensure that, before commencing employment, every person employed in a Child Care centre it operates and every volunteer or student who is on an educational placement with the licensee has a health assessment and immunization as directed by the local medical officer of health."

RCDHU's Medical Officer of Health (MOH) requires all Child Care employees, students, and volunteers to have up-to-date immunizations when they start work or an educational placement (see Appendix E for requirements). There is no specific requirement for a health assessment in addition to these immunizations. The immunizations are to be kept on file by the Child Care facility.

It is important that employees have up to date immunizations to protect themselves and the children under their care against vaccine preventable diseases. Note that, RCDHU does not collect and review the immunization records of employees.

## Licensed Child Care Immunization Program Questionnaire

#### Dear Parent/Guardian:

Children attending licensed Child Care facilities in Ontario must have proof of Immunization against Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio, Haemophilus influenzae B (Hib), Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Rotavirus, Pneumococcal, Meningococcal and Varicella. Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) is required to have this information by law according to the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014, S.O. 2014.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to update RCDHU with all Immunizations. Health Care Providers do not routinely forward Immunization records to RCDHU. If a record indicating all the required immunizations or a signed exemption form has not been provided, your child may not be able to attend a licensed Child Care facility.

## Report Your Immunization Records

Each time your child receives a vaccination, you are required to update Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) directly, as well as your Child Care Facility.

Please note: Health care providers and child care providers do not report immunization records for you.

#### Immunizations for Employees Working in Child Care Facilities

According to the Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014, "Every licensee of a childcare centre shall ensure that, before commencing employment, every person employed in a child care facility it operates and every volunteer or student who is on an educational placement with the licensee has a health assessment and immunization as directed by the local medical officer of health."

Renfrew County and District Health Unit's Medical Officer of Health (MOH) requires all child care employees, students, and volunteers to have up-to-date immunizations as listed when they start work or an educational placement. There is no specific requirement for a health assessment in addition to these immunizations. The immunizations are to be kept on file by the child care facility.

An employee who objects to vaccines directed by the MOH due to <u>medical</u> or <u>non-medical</u> reasons must complete a standardized approved exemption form from the Ministry of Education and provide it to the childcare licensee.

In the event of an outbreak related to a vaccine preventable disease, Renfrew County and District Health Unit may order the exclusion of persons who have an incomplete immunization record from presence at a child care facility until the risk related to the outbreak has ended.

If the parents request an exemption for Medical/
Conscience, Religious beliefs instruct parent to contact RCDHU, or direct to appropriate form



Collect all completed forms from the parent/guardian as their children are enrolled.

Ensure a completed copy of the child's Immunization record is submitted with the Program Questionnaire



Program questionnaire and one copy of the immunization record is to be forwarded to RCDHU via email or fax

**Existing Registrants** 



Ensure Immunizations are up to date as per the publicly funded schedule, use the **assessment tool** and consult a public health nurse at RCDHU as needed.



Ensure parent/guardian update child care facility every time the child receives an immunization as child care facility must maintain a record on site



Remind parent/guardian to update RCDHU directly when child receives vaccine. Provide Parent Handout – 'Reporting your Immunizations' as needed and instruct parent to contact RCDHU if they have questions or require an immunization appointment.
